JOB VS CAREER

The words "job" and "career" are sometimes used interchangeably, but their definitions are vastly different. Let's explore how a job can lead to a fulfilling career.

What is a job?

A job is tasked work for which you are paid.

For example, Noah wanted to earn money to buy an electric guitar. Because he liked dogs, he started a job (a paid task) as a dog walker in his neighborhood.

What is a career?

A career, on the other hand, is paid work a person pursues for the majority of their life that may involve formal education, special training, and it is often within a specific industry.

For example, while working as a dog-walker, Noah met two people who had careers in animal care - a dog trainer and a veterinarian.

While not all dog trainers are doctors, this dog trainer was actually a Doctor of Animal Behavior. This dog trainer trained dogs to be support companions for veterans.

The veterinarian was a doctor who diagnosed and treated the medical conditions and diseases of animals.

After meeting both of these animal doctors, Noah wanted to know more about pursuing a career with animals beyond his part-time job. He job-shadowed both the veterinarian and the animal behaviorist for the day. While at the locations, Noah realized that there were even more careers available for animal-lovers like dog groomer, veterinary technician, and kennel assistant.

Also, there were specialists within the veterinary field like veterinary dentists, veterinary eye doctors, and veterinary neurologists. All of the careers required differing amounts of schooling, degrees, training, and certificates.

Finding a career that interests you can sometimes take years. Your likes and dislikes may change, so explore all your interests. Right now, Noah is interested in animals and music, so he will be exploring careers in both industries.

Why is a job or career important?

Job or career choices determine your income, and your income influences your ability to budget, spend, save, and share. Your income can determine where you live, where you work, how you get there, and how you spend your free time.

Have fun exploring, reading, and researching any job or career that you might like. Think about what problems you would like to solve and investigate what it would take to solve them. Your interests may lead you to a job or a career that doesn't even exist today so be open to changes.



RECIPE FUN - PIZZA TOAST

Everyone loves it!

- · 6 slices of bread
- 6 tablespoons prepared pizza sauce.
- 1 ½ cups shredded mozzarella cheese
- 1 (5 ounce) package mini pepperoni

Preheat oven to 400 degrees.

Spray baking sheet with non-stick cooking spray.

Space the bread slices on the baking sheet.

Bake for 5 minutes until just starting to toast.

Remove from oven and spread each slice with 1 tablespoon pizza sauce, sprinkle with ¼ cup shredded mozzarella, and garnish with about 16 mini pepperoni per toast.

Return to oven for 8-10 minutes or until cheese is melted.
